MESSAGE FROM OUR BOARD PRESIDENT

We hope 2025 was as fruitful for all of you as it was for us! There are far too many incredible moments to highlight in a limited amount of space, so we are choosing a few and if you want more information, reach out – we would love to hear from you!

Each year on April 28th, we host a downtown **Indianapolis Memorial Walk for Workers' Memorial Day**. This event allows those who have been impacted by worker loss to reflect and pay tribute to the lives lost by gathering with others who have experienced similar heartbreak. This year's Workers' Memorial Walk was a great turnout and quite a success. We raised 3x the amount of funds as our previous walks, with the total raised tipping **over \$750.00**. We had 23 walkers and 3 dogs this year, and those who pushed through for the long walk – we went 4.5 total miles. We do this walk due to the importance of remembering those who have lost their lives while working, and we plan to continue to expand this memorial event each year. We hope to see you at our next walk this April. Stay tuned for more information as we get closer.

On September 17th, we came together again for our **Annual Scholarship Golf Outing** at Ironwood Golf Club in Fishers, IN. In a single day, we raised more than **\$60,000.00 PROFIT!** All the proceeds for this event go towards scholarships for so many deserving children and it's exciting to work with the community year after year to grow this incredible event. The weather was beautiful, and the day was absolutely perfect.

Our **3rd Annual Trivia Night** took place on November 13th at Half Liter BBQ in Broad Ripple and was sold out within the first 30 days of opening registration! We sold 163 tickets, though some were donated back, leaving us with a grand total of 147 attendees. 17 teams showed for a LOT of fun, friendly competition! Some of the best moments from the night were the team names, with a favorite being "Trivia Newton John". We kept our expenses low and increased our revenue, ending with a net **profit of \$10,100.00**, a 30% increase from the prior year! We are already talking about the 4th annual event, and if we can offer any advice, it would be to **REGISTER EARLY!** Stay tuned on a date and registration link near the end of the summer.




